Dear Robbie Williams fan,

We would like you to carefully read the following so we can make sure that everyone will enjoy the show and we do not face delays at the entrance.

FORBIDDEN

For safety reasons it is forbidden to bring glass bottles, cans, hard packaging or any objects that may be used as a throwing device (deoderant, perfume,...) to the venue. Therefore these items will be collecting at the entrance point.

Furthermore it is not allowed to bring professional cameras such as reflex cameras, cameras with zoom objectives and/or the function to videotape, professional digital cameras, any recording device or laserpointers.

Bags shall be DIN A4 (21cm x 29,7cm) or smaller!

- **kleine Damenhandtaschen**
- **fanny packs**
- **tote bags/gym bags**

So please leave the following items at home in ordert o quicken the security check:

- **backpacks, big bags or suitcases**
- **professional cameras with an interchangeable lens**

- audio and videotaping devices
- GoPro cameras
- selfie sticks
- electronic devices such as tablets, laptops, powerbanks etc.
- Food and alcoholic drinks. 1 non alcoholic drink 0,5l max per person in tetra containment or PET plastic bottle is allowed.
- chairs
- weapons, knives, taser, batons, pepperspray,...
- torches, glowsticks, chains, laserpointer
- big flags and posters (incl. sticks)
- helmets
- big umbrellas

There are extra wardrobes outside the venue with a limited capacity for items that are not allowed inside. 2,00 € per item will be charged! Wardrobes can be found Horst-Korber-Sportcentre (1x entrance Glockenturmstr. and 1x entrance Passenheimer Str.

Please be aware of the venue regulations!

MISCELLANEOUS

Refreshment stations with a big diversity of different drinks and food can be found on the whole ground including the infield. For your own good only Tetra Pak or plastic bottles containing max. 0,5l (non alcoholic and sealed) will be allowed on site.

Don't forget to bring sunblock and something to cover your head / rainproof clothing.

Loud music may damage your ears! Please be reminded that ear protection is very important especially for children. We advise you to not bring your kids to the show when they are under 8!

There will be medical staff on site for any emergencies.

TRAVEL

There is only a limited amount of parking lots in the direct environment of the venue. Therefore we advise to travel with the public local transport. For visitors from outside of Berlin we recommend various Park&Ride options.

1. LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT

S-Bahn: Take the S5 – exit stop „Pichelsberg“. Waldbühne is an approximate 10 minute walk away from the train station.

U-Bahn (underground): Take the U2 til Olympiastadion. It's a 20 minute walk to the venue.

Bus: take line M49 or 218 relevant stops are: Ragniter Allee / Scholzplatz.

2. CAR

Enter Navigation: Glockenturmstraße 1, 14053 Berlin

Coming from Hamburg/Rostock:

- Exit Kaiserdamm
- Direction Charlottenburg on the city highway (A100)
- Exit Kaiserdamm, turn right, and then straight ahead
- stay on Kaiserdamm until you reach Theodor-Heuss-Platz
- take the second exit: Heerstraße, keep right
- turn right into Passenheimer Straße

Coming from Munich/Nuremberg, Hannover/Magdeburg, Leipzig

- via city highway (A115) direction junction Funkturm
- Exit Messedamm (direction A100), keep right
- go straight at the second traffic light.
- go under the bridge of ICC
- turn left into Masurenallee
- take the third exit at Theodor-Heuss-Platz (Heerstraße)
- go straight ahead, keep right
- turn right into Passenheimer Straße

3. AIRPLANE

Berlin has two airports: Berlin-Tegel and Berlin-Schoenefeld erreicht. Distance from Berlin-Tegel ist 11 kilometers, depending on the traffic it takes around 15 minutes by car, cab fee should be around 25 Euros. Schoenefeld is 30 km away and 35 minutes by car. A cab fee should be around 65 Euros.

PARKING

When you're traveling by car go to parking lot P07. Use the entrance on Passenheimer Straße (via Heerstraße)

Parking lots P04 and P05 are accessable in emergencies, all parking lots are metered!

Parking lots for disabled people can be found at P08
You'll need proof of being disabled by 70% or a vehicle for disabled people.

Parking lots for disabled persons are only available via Passenheimer Straße.

WHEELCHAIR DRIVERS/ PEOPLE WITH WALKING DISABILITIES

The entrance for wheelchair users is just on the right side off he main entrance. Please be aware of all signings, stewards will also guide your way. Wheelchair spots

are just above block K. Toilets are in close range. Your accompanying person may also enter through the sperate entrance. You do not have to stay in the general line!
